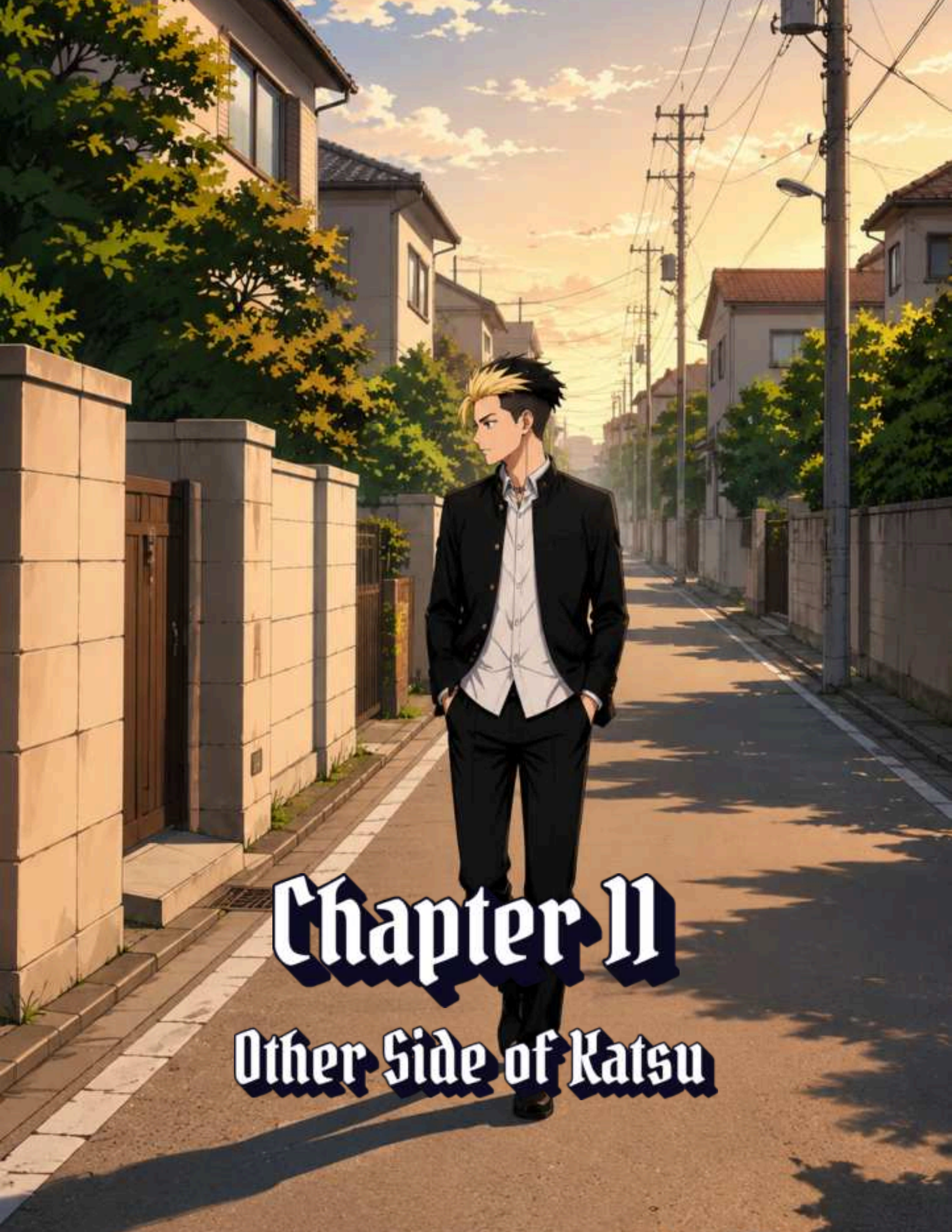

Oni.



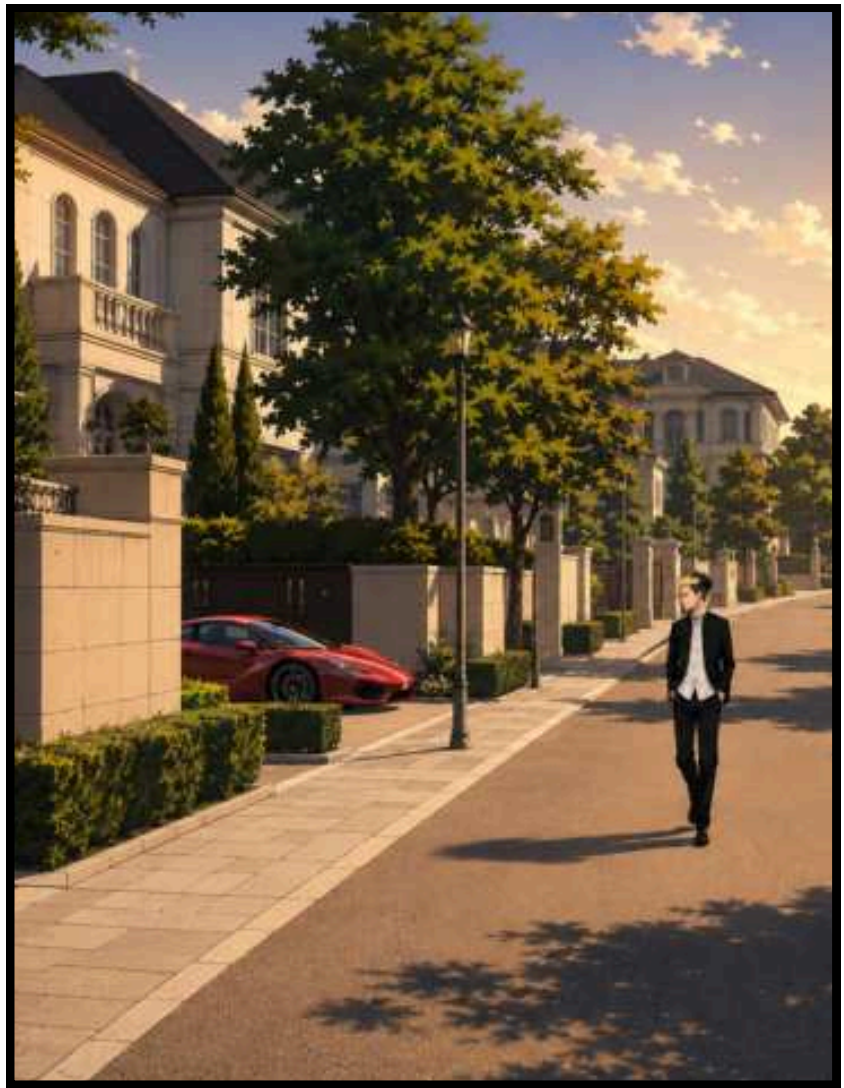

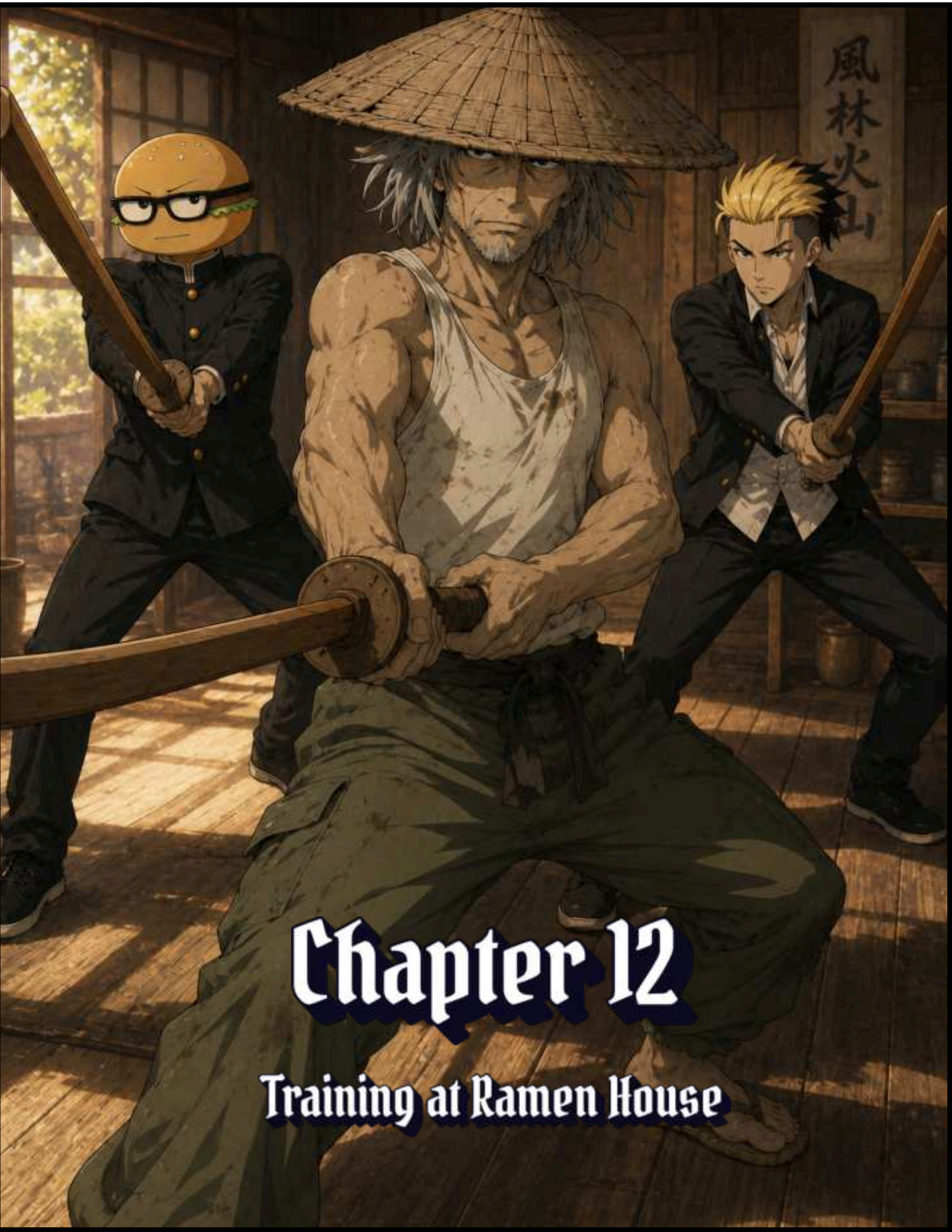








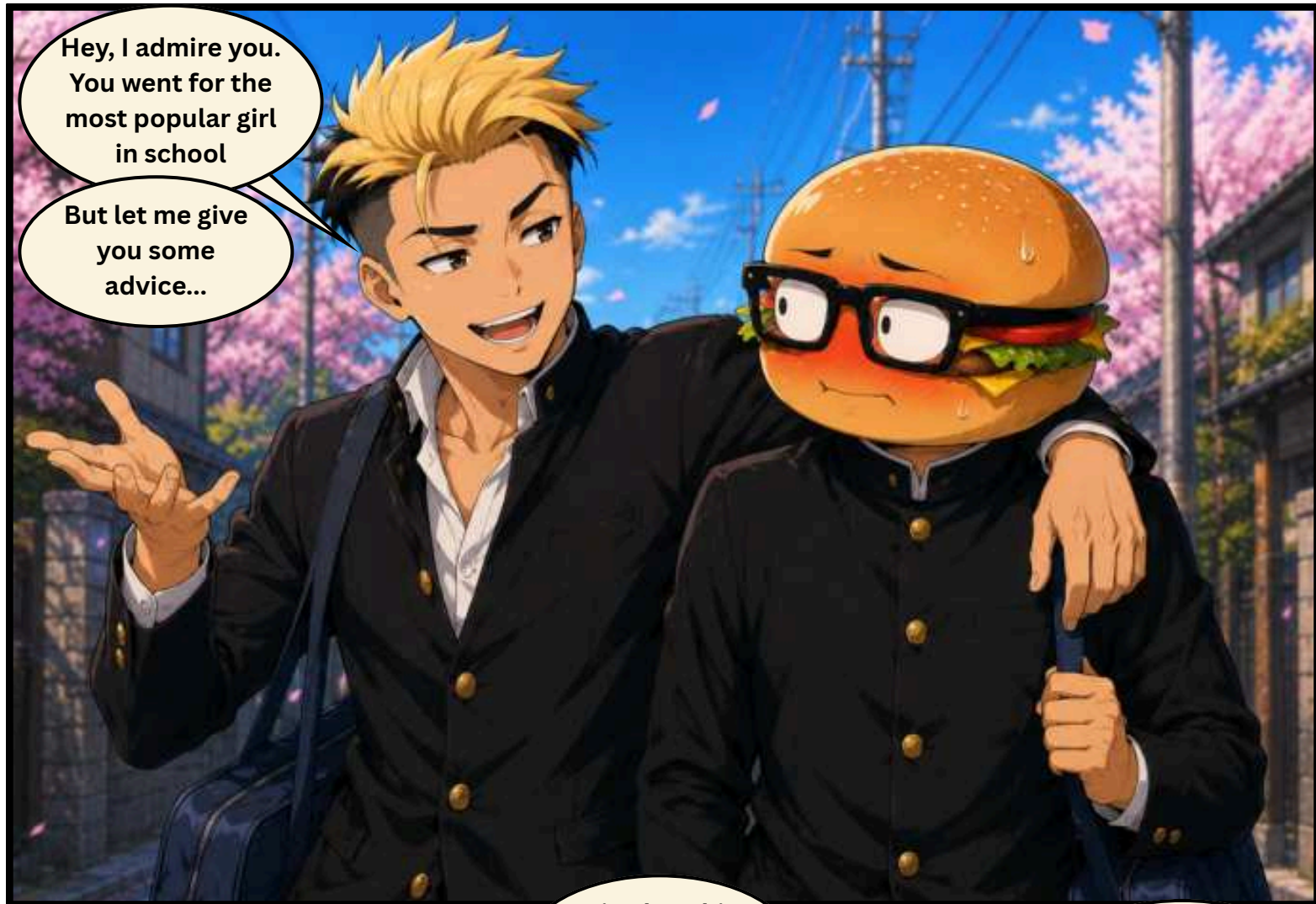




Chapter 12
